- Responsible closure by designing its projects for closure and planning closure methods in consultation with the relevant regional stakeholders.
- Responsible stewardship of water and natural resources and undertake its activities in a manner that aims to reduce, manage, and rectify adverse impacts, and maximises positive environmental benefits.
- Implement risk-based management and governance practices in line with internationally recognised good practice such as the Global Industry Standard on Tailings Management.
- Responsible waste management to protect health and safety and to minimize harmful impacts on the environment.
- Continually assess ways to reduce direct and indirect greenhouse gas emissions and plan future operations to be climate neutral by 2035.
- Respect all environmental designations for protected areas to maintain high quality ecosystem function. Assess, mitigate against and manage risks and impacts to biodiversity with the ambition of achieving no-net-loss of biodiversity. Identify, analyse, and manage environmental risks, aspects and opportunities and implement efficient management systems and action plans according to the ISO 14001
